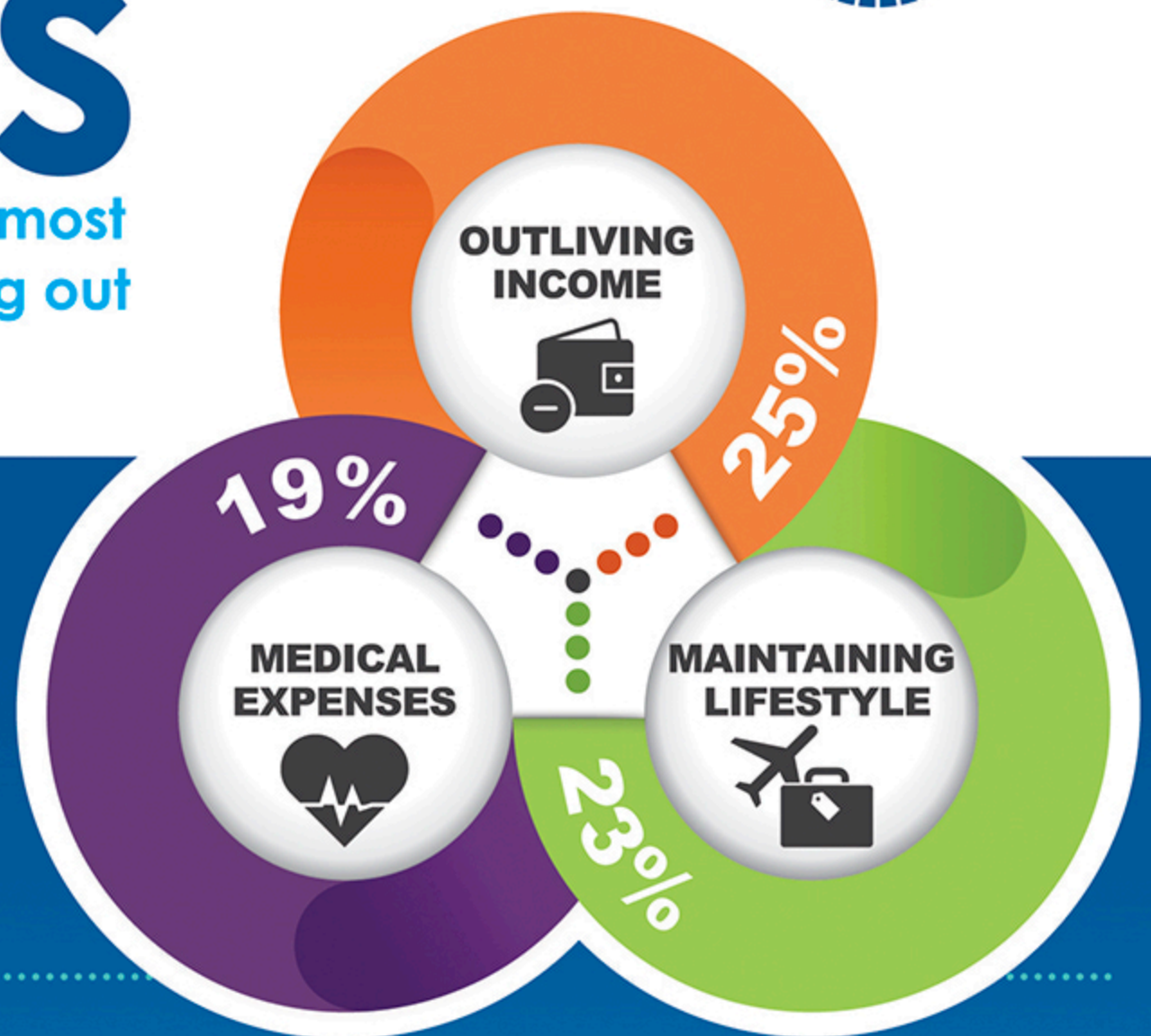


Americans' Greatest Retirement Fears
