Healthy Kids Are Better Students

There is a strong connection between academic performance and a student's health. Medicaid and the Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP) provide school-age children (ages 6-18) with the care they need to improve their ability to fully participate in the classroom and fulfill school health requirements.



WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Children up to age 19 in a family of four earning up to \$50,000 a year or more might be able to qualify for free or low-cost medical coverage through Medicaid or CHIP

MOST UNINSURED CHILDREN ARE ELIGIBLE!

Children with Medicaid and CHIP have access to immunizations, check-ups, eye exams, dental visits, mental health care, prescriptions, and other health services

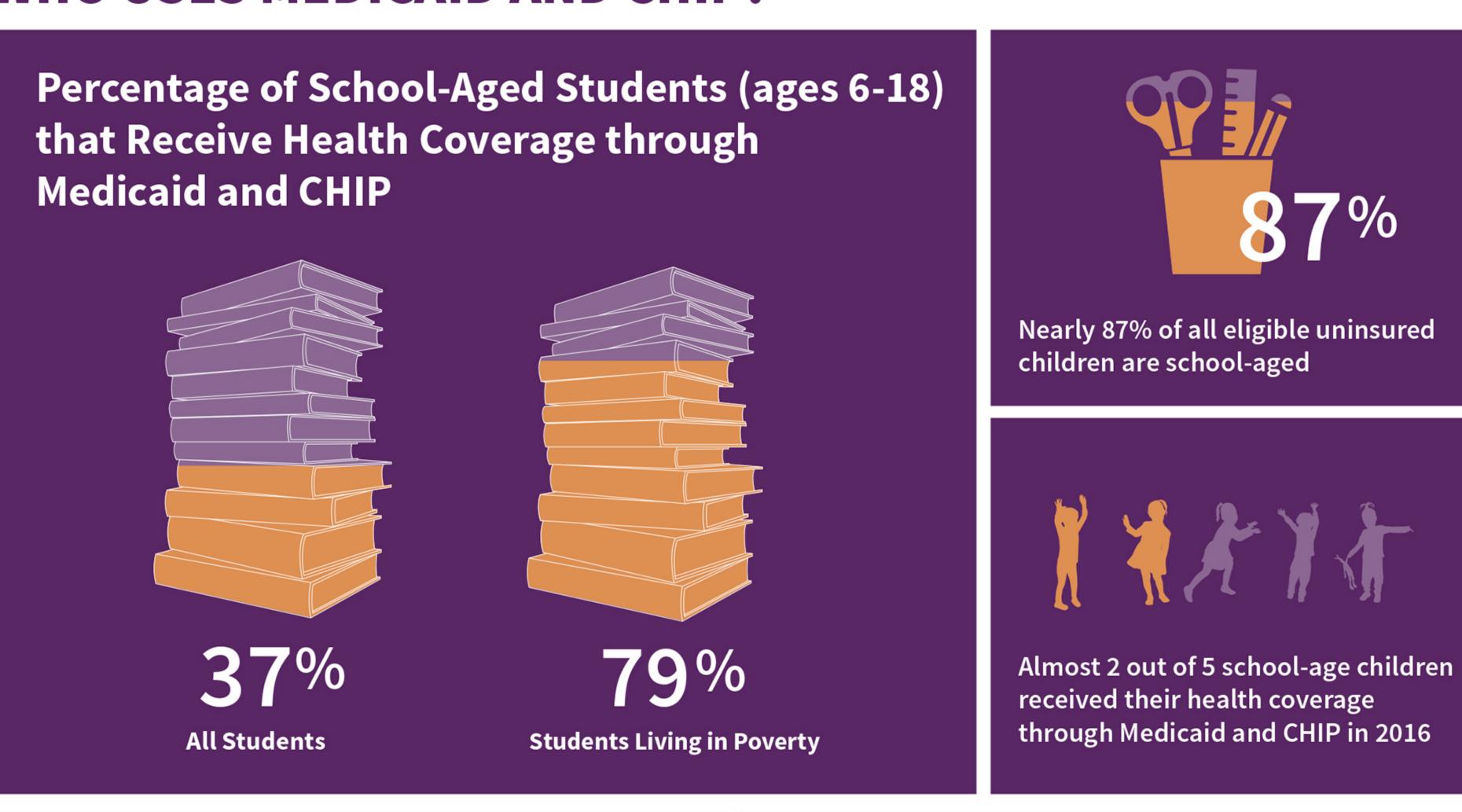
