
# **Lung Health on the Job:**

Know the Risks of Work-Related COPD

Chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, or COPD, is a serious lung disease that makes it hard to breathe and gets worse as time goes on.

The work you do can affect the health of your lungs.



#### How can work affect COPD risk?



Almost 15% of the time, COPD comes from exposure to certain air pollutants at work.

#### **Exposure to pollutants like these** over time can cause COPD:



**Dusts** (coal, silica, asbestos, cotton, wood, grains)



**Fumes** (metal/welding, diesel/engine, asphalt)
